Pursuing the Promise

Did you hear about the miracle in Thailand? "I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father," Jesus explained. (John 14:12). That promise has been happening in Thailand. Missionaries go to Thailand to teach the Thais God's ways, not realizing that often God is also teaching them how God's promises sometimes are experienced equally as powerful among some servants of God in Thailand. Samaan Wannakiat is such a leader. This evangelist, who according to his upcoming book, The Miracle Man, is used by God to heal people. He turns 85 years old this June,

consummating 55 years in ministry. Like Caleb in the Bible, he is pursuing a promise of God while others his age are in retirement. He knows there is no job shortage or unemployment in God's economy. In fact, he endeavors to continue outreach to those who have yet to know Christ by partnering with local pastors to hold evangelistic meetings. Saved under the healing ministry of Rev. T. L. Osborn when he was a young man and miraculously cured of a heart defect, God honored his request to have a healing ministry like Osborn. Commissioned by God to go out and preach, he has done so faithfully by walking, riding a bicycle, travel-

ing by motorbike, car, truck and more recently his 'Good News' bus, seen in the picture praying for healing. His passion is to be used by God, first, to bring people to Christ, and, second, to heal people. He has been most effective reaching people when he partners with churches to have evangelistic meetings in areas outside of churches as more unsaved people attend, than, they would a church. Yet, his outreaches, have resulted in starting several churches. He hopes to lead over 10 thousand to Christ.



Vision 2010 Conference: May 4-8 with 4,000 Thai Leaders

The goal for Thailand is to have a church in every district by 2010 along with a church group in every village. Currently 215 districts are without any churches, but with God all things are possible (Mark 9:23). What is needed to meet this goal is nothing less than God's outpouring on this na-

tion, and more faithful workers partnering together for evangelistic outreach and church plant projects. There are 4,016 churches in Thailand. The crucial question is how many of these churches and prospective churches will impact their community by witnessing and starting other

churches? Out of over 63 million people only **0.51%** are Christians, around 323,648 including hill tribes. Hill tribes in the North are coming to Christ at a faster rate than the Thais at 10%. Northeast, the largest region, has over 21 million people and the lowest number of Christians at 0.16%. Please pray.
